FINAL ORDER

On September 16, 2016, the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (Department) executed an Administrative Complaint charging Respondent with violating the Public Health Code, MCL 333.1101 et seq.

An administrative hearing was held in this matter before an administrative law judge who, on March 10, 2017, issued a Proposal for Decision (PFD) setting forth recommended Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

On March 31, 2017, the Department of Attorney General, Licensing and Regulation Division, on behalf of the Department, filed Petitioner's Exceptions to Proposal for Decision.

On May 15, 2017, Respondent filed Respondent [REDACTED] Response to Petitioner's Exceptions.
